

This partnership continues as an essential element of the WFD-CTE Coalition's operations.

In 2021 the WFD-CTE Coalition moved to better organize itself and created an Advisory Council to provide leadership and operating objectives for the Coalition.

At the March 2022 ACTE Board of Directors meeting, the Board approved a new Liaison to represent and report on the Coalition's work. You can view the current WFD-CTE Advisory Council members on our website.

In 2023, the WFD-CTE Coalition developed a strategic plan which will be rolled out at the Summit and implemented through December 31, 2026.


